

2013-2014 Student Statistics Report

Snapshot Findings

- In 2014, Australia is predicted to graduate 3549 doctors (domestic and international). This compares with 439 from New Zealand.
- There will be a plateauing of medical graduate numbers in Australia from 2015. (This was expected to have occurred in 2014 but there were fewer than expected predicted graduates for 2014 - see below). We can now expect 3700-**3750 Australian graduates per year** (domestic and international) (assuming no attrition).
- Since 2010 we have reached relatively stable numbers of **international graduates** from Australian medical schools of around 510-570 per year. This will likely continue until at least 2018.
- In 2014 34.4% of Australian graduates will come from NSW/ACT medical schools followed by Queensland with 23.2%
- There has been a slight gradual reduction in the **% of female** Australian graduates plateauing now at around 50%
- In 2014 **27.6% of commencing domestic** students in Australia come from a rural background compared with 22% in 2008. This compares with 17.25% in New Zealand in 2014.
- In 2014 26.3% (803) of Australian domestic graduates will be bonded either through the BMP or MRBS to work in areas of workforce shortage. By 2017 this will be 27.3% or approximately 887 graduates (assuming no attrition)
- In 2014 6.7% of Australian Domestic commencing students are full fee paying and the majority of these come from 3 schools. This compares with 4.3% in 2010
- In 2013, 24 more Indigenous doctors graduated from medical programs in Australia. This compares with 35 Maori doctors in New Zealand.
- A further 81 Australian and 73 New Zealand Indigenous students enrolled in year one of medicine in 2014



These graduate numbers exclude offshore cohorts including Ochsner, Brunei, IMU and Monash Malaysia




Actual graduations usually differ from predicted graduations by a factor of - 0.8% when modelled on final year enrollments

The predicted graduate numbers for 2014 differ by 120 (3.27% less) from the prediction made in 2013. This is likely due to an i) an outlier effect from Monash where a larger than usual cohort of BMedSci intermitting students exited between the penultimate and final years and ii) a slightly higher overall attrition rate between these two years of 2.15% (taking out the outlier) vs 1.85% in 2013.




